Asynchronous Resource Growth

Resource development has become a significant component of Consortium work. The rapid implementation of new curriculum's at the Elementary level has created an imperative to provide educators with quality resources to support the implementation process.

The following statistics show not only the magnitude of what has been accomplished, but also the reach and impact of the resources that have been created.

- The [Consortium Website](#) traffic increased **964%** with 850,940 page views, up from 88,248 in the previous year.
- The [Consortium YouTube channel](#) increased **368%** with 48,134 views up from 13,091 in the previous year.
